### Minutes of the Vance County Board of Education

### August 13, 2012

The Vance County Board of Education met in regular session on Monday, August 13, 2012, 7:00 p.m.. Administrative Services Center Board Room. Board members present were: Gloria J. White, Chair, Darlynn P. Oxendine, Vice Chair, Emeron J. Cash, Sr., Margaret A. Ellis, Ruth M. Hartness and Dorothy M. Williams. Ronald B. Kinsley was out of town. Senior staff members present were: Ronald E. Gregory, Superintendent, Dr. Trixie J. Brooks, Assistant Superintendent for Curriculum and Instruction, Brian Creasman, Assistant Superintendent for Administration/Instructional Support, Wil McLean, Executive Director of Human Resources, Steven Graham, Finance Officer, Terri Hedrick, Public Information Officer, and Jerry Stainback, Attorney for the Board.

- 1. Mrs. White called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. and welcomed everyone attending. A moment of silence was observed.
- 2. Upon motion by Mrs. Hartness, second by Mrs. Oxendine, the Board unanimously (6-0) approved the minutes of the June 11, 21 & July 12, 2012 meetings as presented.
- 3. Upon motion by Mr. Cash, second by Ms. Williams, the Board unanimously (6-0) approved the meeting agenda with the following changes.
  - Add Scott Populorum to VI.A, Comments from the Public
  - Add Personnel Addendum to VIII.A
  - Add two (2) student transfer requests to X.B

### 4. Recognitions/Announcements

New principals for the 2012-2013 school year were introduced by Mr. Gregory. They are Heddie Somerville, principal of Pinkston Street Elementary School; David Westbrook, principal of Carver Elementary School; Stephanie Ayscue, principal of Southern Vance High School, and Michael Applewhite, principal of Northern Vance High School. Prior to being named principal of their school, Mrs. Somerville, Mr. Westbrook and Mrs. Ayscue served as assistant principals in the Vance County School System. Dr. Applewhite, a native of Vance County and graduate of Vance Senior High School, thanked the Board for the opportunity to return to the county.

Mrs. White introduced Dr. Trixie Brooks as Assistant Superintendent for Curriculum/Instruction. Dr. Brooks previously served as the Executive Director for Curriculum/Instruction. Brian Creasman, former principal of Northern Vance High School, was introduced as Assistant Superintendent for Administration/Instructional Support.

Mrs. White apologized to both for not introducing them to the new teachers at the New Teacher Orientation.

### 5. Comments from the Public

A. Scott Populorum, founder of Public School Outreach Ministries, presented information to Board Members about his ministry and desire to conduct Bible Clubs in the schools. His previous requests to use a school facility have been denied. Mr. Populorum stated he currently has approximately 820 names on a petition to allow his ministry to use the schools' facilities. He is seeking permission to use a school facility each Thursday between October 11, 2012 and April 18, 2013 to hold Bible Clubs immediately after school. Mr. Populorum will complete the Facility Use Application during the week of September 20, 2012. He thanked Board members for allowing him to speak.

### 6. Superintendent's Report

(1) Wanda Bullard, Director of Accountability, provided an update on the ABC/AMOs (Annual Measureable Objectives) for the 2011-2012 School Year.

Results from the State end-of-grade and end-of course testing showed 13 out of 16 schools met growth and seven (7) out of 16 schools met high growth. Both Aycock Elementary and Vance County Early College were recognized as N. C. Schools of Distinction. Ten schools were N. C. Schools of Progress. Within the 10 schools, five (5) schools met high growth standards (Dabney Elementary, Pinkston Street Elementary, Southern Vance High, Northern Vance High and Zeb Vance Elementary) and five (5) met expected growth (Carver Elementary, Eaton Johnson Middle, New Hope Elementary, E. O. Young Elementary and L. B. Yancey Elementary). Western Vance High School was recognized as an Alternative School meeting high growth standards. Two (2) schools (Clarke Elementary and E. M. Rollins Elementary) received no recognition. Henderson Middle School was designated as a N. C. Priority School.

Six (6) schools met all AMO Targets, formerly Adequate Yearly Progress. The schools included Carver Elementary, New Hope Elementary, Pinkston Street Elementary, Western Vance High, Northern Vance High and Vance County Early College.

Mrs. Bullard also reported on the four-year graduation rate for 2012. The overall rate for Vance County Schools was 68.2%. Northern Vance graduated 75.6%, Southern Vance graduated 69.9% and Western Vance graduated 92.5%

Mr. Gregory briefly updated the Board on the use of the media centers during the summer to offer students an opportunity to continue reading and improve their reading skills. Fifty-seven students used the media centers this summer compared to 42 students in 2011.

(2) Dr. Brooks gave an update on the Early High School Stem Program (EHS<sup>2</sup>P). Teachers are in place and the area looks great. Teachers participated in three (3) days of training on the campus of N. C. State University to become familiar with the Design Thinking process. Senior mentors have been identified and will be trained to expose STEM students to rigorous courses such as AP and Honors. Smartboards have been purchased and installed as well as white boards, bulletin boards, student tables and chairs. Walls have been painted. Signs were purchased for the outside and inside of the building to assure easy identification of the program. School logistics such as movement patterns, bell schedules, start and dismissal procedures, breakfast and lunch procedures have been determined. Student schedules have been finalized. In addition to the core areas of instruction, students will participate in an elective rotation wheel. The goal is to have STEM students take Algebra I, English I and Spanish I in grade 8.

The district Reading Specialist and Northern Vance Media Specialist are working together to support the need of middle school books. Classroom libraries have been purchased.

Mrs. White stated she had visited the site and everything looks really good. Mrs. Hartness asked if there will be new books added to the media center. Dr. Brooks stated they will make sure there are appropriate materials for sixth graders. Mr. Gregory stated the books in the media center ranges from sixth grade through college level.

(3) Dr. Brooks briefly updated the Board on the Summer Reading Camp. The Reading Camp was held from July 16, 2012 – August 2, 2012 for students in third grade that did not perform well on the N. C. End of Grade test. The camp located at Dabney Elementary and L. B. Yancey Elementary ran Monday through Thursday from 9:00 a.m. – 1:00 p.m. Lunch and transportation were provided for students. A total of 83 students attended with 10 teachers employed to focus on reading skills. Funding was provided through Title 1.

Reading Express, which is a targeted intervention and instruction program, was purchased for the camp. Materials provided intensive intervention on the essential reading standards and enhanced literacy skills and were aligned with Common Core.

A total of 45 students attended the L. B. Yancey Reading Camp. Following the post-test, 28 students improved in their reading, 5 students showed no improvement, 1 student remained the same and 11 students were absent or left the camp.

At Dabney a total of 38 students attended the Reading Camp. Following the post-test, 24 students improved in their reading, 4 students showed no improvement, 6 students stayed the same and 4 students were absent or left the camp.

Teachers were given an opportunity to provide feedback upon completion of the camp through a survey. Survey results were provided to the Board.

Mr. Gregory stated under Senate Bill 795, Excellent Schools Act, that students must be reading on a third grade level at the end of the 2012-2013 school year in order to be considered for promotion. Students not reading on a third grade level will be mandated to attend a Summer Reading Camp under the new Senate Bill.

- (4) Mr. Gregory informed the Board that repairs were made to two (2) chillers in order to be ready for the return of students. Expansion valves and module were replaced on chiller #2 at Northern Vance High School at a cost of \$9.019.69. A compressor was replaced on chiller #1 at Henderson Middle School at a cost of \$6.378.43.
- (5) Mr. Gregory shared information on five (5) bonus days given to all employees who were employed on or before July 1, 2012. He stated that the legislators had included the bonus days along with a 1.2% increase for all State employees. The days must be used by June 30, 2013. Ten (10) month employees are limited in the days they can use the bonus days within the school calendar. Therefore, Mr. Gregory stated that the bonus days will be designated as December 27, 28, & 31, 2012 and March 27 & 28, 2013. Ten-month employees will gain the five (5) designated annual leave days which can be carried over to the next school year. Employees not eligible for the bonus days will use their designated annual leave days.
- (6) Mr. Gregory extended an invitation to the Board from the Henderson-Vance Community Watch Association to participate in a Panel Discussion on Education on Thursday. September 27, 2012, at 7:00 p.m. The meeting will be held in the auditorium at Maria Parham Medical Center.
- (7) Mr. Gregory shared the Organizational Chart with the Board. Duties have been distributed between Dr. Brooks, Mr. Creasman and Mr. Gregory.
- (8) Mr. Graham presented the 2012-2013 Bank Signature Authority list for Board approval.
  - Upon motion by Mrs. Oxendine, second by Ms. Williams, the Board unanimously (6-0) approved the Listing of Bank Signature Authorities for the 2012-2013 fiscal year.
- (9) Mr. Gregory stated the Board had previously approved a request to use the Clarke Elementary close-out funds of approximately \$350,000 to renovate the Eaton Johnson two-story building for the STEM program. The County Commissioners denied the request. The STEM program slated to open for students on August 27, 2012 will be located at Northern Vance High School.

Mr. Gregory requested the Board to approve the use of the close-out funds to refurbish the science labs at Northern Vance High School. The labs are 44 years old. Mrs. White agreed that something should be done.

Mrs. Oxendine stated the labs have not been upgraded since the school was built. However, she asked if the funds could be used for a multipurpose room at Carver Elementary. It is a major concern that needs to be resolved for the 200+ students without a gymnasium. Mrs. White agreed, but reminded Mrs. Oxendine that the commissioners did not approve the earlier request for a multipurpose room.

Upon motion by Mr. Cash, second by Mrs. Ellis, the Board unanimously (6-0) voted to request from the Board of Commissioners the close-out funds from the Clarke Elementary project to upgrade the science labs at Northern Vance High School.

### 7. Board of Education Standing Committees
