

NOTICE OF DEMOCRATIC, REPUBLICAN, LIBERTARIAN, NON-PARTISAN PRIMARIES, AND CITY OF HENDERSON ELECTION

Pursuant to General Statute 163.33(8), the Vance County Board of Elections hereby gives notice that the 2012 Democratic Primary, 2012 Republican Primary, 2012 Libertarian Primary, 2012 Non-Partisan Primary, and the City of Henderson Municipal Election will be held in Vance County on Tuesday, May 8, 2012. The polls will open at 6:30 AM and will close at 7:30 PM. Registered voters will be choosing the following:

DEMOCRATIC PRIMARY

LIBERTARIAN PRIMARY

NON-PARTISAN PRIMARY

Large County Seat - if you live in the City of Henderson)

The North Carolina Democratic, Republican, and Libertarian parties are allowing unaffiliated voters to participate in their party primary elections. Those persons registered as unaffiliated may request either a Democratic ballot, Republican ballot, a Libertarian ballot or a Non-Partisan ballot.

Absentee ballots by mail are allowed. Requests for an absentee ballot by mail must be made in writing and received in the Vance County Board of Elections office by 5:00 PM on Tuesday, May 1, 2012. Absentee voting by mail is going on now and ends on Tuesday, May 1, 2012.

One-stop absentee voting will be held in the Board of Elections Office and at the Henderson Operational Center. Beginning on Thursday, April 19, 2012 and ending on Saturday, May 5, 2012, One-stop voting hours are Thursday, April 19, 2012 and Friday April 20, 2012- 8:30 AM to 5:00 PM at both locations. Monday, April 23, 2012 - Friday, April 27, 2012- 8:30 AM to 5:00 PM at both locations. Monday, April 30, 2012 - Friday, May 4, 2012- 8:30 AM to 5:00 PM at both locations and on Saturday, May 5, 2012- 8:30 AM to 1:00 PM at both locations. Canvass will be held at 11:00 AM on Tuesday, May 15, 2012 in the Vance County Board of Elections Office.

All residents of the City of Henderson and those that live out in the County who are registered to vote with the Vance County Board of Elections may vote in this election. Voters who are previously registered need not re-register for this election. Those residents of the City of Henderson and the ones that live out in the County who are not registered to vote must register on or before Friday, April 13, 2012 in order to vote in this election. Alternatively you may register and, if eligible then vote at any one-stop site in your county of residence.
