Minutes of the Vance County Board of Education

September 9, 2013

The Vance County Board of Education met in regular session on Monday, September 9, 2013, 7:00 p.m., Administrative Services Center Board Room. Board members present were: Gloria J. White, Chair, Darlynn P. Oxendine, Vice Chair, Emeron J. Cash, Sr., Margaret A. Ellis, Dorothy M. Williams and Edward B. Wilson. Board member Ruth M. Hartness was unable to attend. Senior staff members present were: Ronald E. Gregory, Superintendent, Dr. Trixie J. Brooks, Assistant Superintendent for Curriculum and Instruction, Dr. Brian K. Creasman, Assistant Superintendent for Administration/ Instructional Support, Terri Hedrick, Public Information Officer, Angela Miles, Assistant Director for Human Resources, and Robert Newby, Finance Officer.

WHEREAS, Mrs. Johnnie Jacqueline Young Mims Sanders remains an active member of the Golden Age Club, the North Carolina Senior Citizens, the National Council of Senior Citizens, the North Carolina Visually Impaired, the North Carolina Association of Educators and a representative for the Senior Health Insurance Program and has been a part of many organizations and committees at the county, state and national level through the United Shiloh Missionary Baptist Association, the Woman's Baptist Home and Foreign Missionary Convention of North Carolina, the General Baptist State Convention, the Lott Carey Foreign Missions Convention and the Progressive National Baptist Convention; and

WHEREAS, Mrs. Johnnie Jacqueline Young Mims Sanders is being honored for her 100th birthday on Saturday, November 2, 2013, by Shiloh Baptist Church in Henderson, North Carolina;

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VANCE COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION COMMUNITY AND BUSINESS RELATIONS COMMITTEE

Minutes Monday, September 23, 2013

The Community and Business Relations Committee met at 5:30 p.m. on Monday, September 23, 2013, at the Administrative Services Center. Those present were Dorothy Williams, chairperson of the committee and a Board of Education member; Darlynn Oxendine, vice chairperson of the Board of Education; Margaret Ellis, a Board of Education member; Superintendent Ronald E. Gregory; Brian Creasman, assistant superintendent; Dr. Trixie Brooks, assistant superintendent; and Terri Hedrick, public information officer.

Proposed Reading Initiative for Third Grade from United Way of Vance County:

Terri Hedrick reported to committee members that the United Way of Vance County wants to partner with the school system to promote and coordinate a new reading initiative program designed to assist third graders across the district in being proficient readers at the end of the school year. The local United Way's Board of Directors voted to make the reading initiative the focus of their efforts throughout this school year. The organization's decision is based on expectations of the new N.C. Read to Achieve program, approved by the N.C. General Assembly, that establishes the goal of having all third graders reading at or above grade level by the end of the school year. United Way officials want to appeal to local civic organizations, churches, businesses, government agencies and individuals to volunteer in schools to work with students on their reading skills and to seek funding to buy new books for third graders to establish home libraries. Mrs. Hedrick noted that the next step involves having United Way leaders meet with all elementary principals and third-grade teachers to develop a plan to promote, advocate and seek funds to support the reading initiative in the community. An important part of the meeting will be to get input from teachers and school administrators on the best strategies for volunteers to help third graders to improve their reading skills. Plans call for the meeting to be held by mid-October. An update will be provided at the next committee meeting.

New Guidelines for School Volunteers and Update on Moms and Pops Program:

Mrs. Hedrick noted that criminal background checks are being done this school year on all individuals who want to volunteer in our schools, even if they have volunteered in past years. A large number of school volunteers have completed paperwork and had their criminal background checks completed, so that they can begin helping in the schools. Many of the volunteers include individuals who are helping in the Moms and Pops program, a new program this year that has adult volunteers patrolling hallways and areas at each school to serve as another set of eyes for school administrators to ensure students are where they need to be, no unauthorized persons are on school grounds and all school entrances and exits are secure during the school day. Mrs. Hedrick noted that Moms and Pops volunteers are wearing bright, yellow vests to identify them while they are volunteering in schools.

Assessment of Closure of Elementary After School Programs:

Mrs. Hedrick noted that the five elementary after school sites at Aycock, Dabney, Zeb Vance, E.M. Rollins and E.O. Young Jr. elementary schools were closed on June 6. Through the summer, after school officials assisted parents in getting information for other local child care program options for the summer and the new school year. She added that her office is in the process of trying to collect \$4,762 in unpaid balances from parents whose children received services last school year.

Information Items:

Several information items were shared with committee members including:

- Save Our Kids water safety classes have resumed for all second graders;
- The Teacher Executive Institute program for 2013-2014 begins October 3;
- Southern Vance High School will host the N.C. Barbell, Weightlifting and Strength Sports Hall of Fame inductions on October 12, including the induction of Ralph Peace, former director of the Henderson-Vance Parks & Recreation Department;
- All fifth graders will participate in Environmental Field Days near Satterwhite Point on Kerr Lake on October 22 and 23;
- Vance County Schools will announce our Teacher of the Year, Principal of the Year and Assistant Principal of the Year and honor all nominees for the awards at an event on November 5;
- A Vance County Education Summit, led by the Vance County Board of Commissioners, will be held on November 12 from 8:30 a.m. to 1:30 p.m. at a location to be determined.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 6:15 p.m.
