Reverse Raffle Rules

- Maximum number of tickets to be sold – 124 (# 001 - # 124)
- Cost per ticket - \$150 (with dinner for 2) \$100 (no attendance at night event)
- The terms Ticket and Ball are one and the same, both representing the number on the ticket.
- Ticket #125 will be auctioned the night of the raffle after the 115th ball is drawn – guaranteed to be in the final 10 balls. The Ball #125 will be placed in the bin after the 115th ball is drawn.
- Winner of any prize need not be present to win.
- All tickets will be drawn in reverse order: The last ticket drawn wins the Grand Prize of \$5,000.
- Other prizes include:
 - Every 10th ticket wins \$100 (#10, #20, #30 etc). The 5th, 15th, 25th.etc. (except for #125) wins a door prize.
 - A ticket to next year's reverse raffle to the 1st ticket drawn.
- When the last FIVE tickets remain, those ticket holders will have the opportunity to decide whether to continue with the raffle or split the \$5,000 prize. If any ONE person wants to continue the raffle will go on. If there is agreement to stop, the Grand Prize will be split. If one or more of the five remaining ticket holders is not present and all of those present wish to stop, those not present will be presumed in agreement.
- Proceeds from the raffle contest will benefit the Vance County Community Foundation Unrestricted Fund.
- Purchase of raffle ticket is not a tax-deductible contribution.
- Must be 21 years of age or older. Delivery of prize money will be made solely to the entrants within two weeks of the Raffle. Winners shall be responsible for any and all federal, state and local income taxes.
