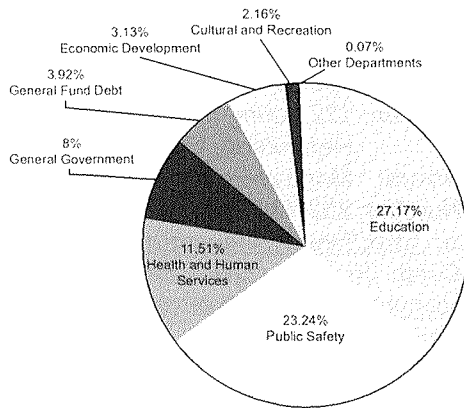
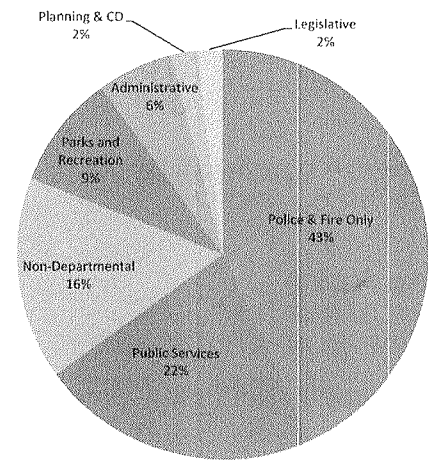


How your tax dollars are spent:

Current year property tax makes up 37 1/2 % of the total General Fund budget

1. Taxes are due on September 1st and if not paid by January 5th 2015 there will be interest added at a rate of 2% to the principal amount and it will increase 3/4% each month thereafter until paid in full. Taxes that are considered delinquent will be advertised in the newspaper in accordance to N.C.G.S. 105-369. You may start making payments upon receipt of this bill; however, taxes not paid in full by January 5th 2015 will be subject to enforcement procedures by the Tax Office. Enforcement actions may include bank account attachment, levy against personal property, wage garnishment, and foreclosure.
2. Payments received by mail are deemed to be received as of the date of the US Postal Service postmark.
3. Return check: 10% of the payment with a minimum penalty of \$25.00 and a maximum of \$1,000.00 will be charged for checks returned due to insufficient funds.
4. In accordance to N.C. General Statute we are required to tax the owner of record as of January 1st. If you have sold your real property please forward this notice to the new owner immediately.
5. Mortgage Escrow: All tax bills are mailed to the owner of record as of January 1st. Most mortgage escrow companies also request a full data file from our office. If you have questions about payment, please contact your mortgage company.
6. Real Value: The value of the property as of January 1st of each year is based on the Vance County's last general reappraisal, which was January 1, 2008.
7. Personal Value: Value is placed on personal property as of January 1st of each year. Personal Property is considered to be the following: boats, motors, mobile homes, jet skis, aircraft, campers, unlicensed vehicles, farm equipment and leasehold improvements used for a trade or business.
8. Pursuant to N.C.G.S. 105-317.1(c), the taxpayer may appeal the value, situs, or taxability of the **personal property** within thirty (30) days after the date of this notice.
9. Business Owners: Under the description column; anything beginning with "SECT" is your business personal property (Machinery & Equipment, Computers, Furniture and Fixtures, Leaseholds, Supplies, etc).

11. **Payments:** To pay by credit card over the internet, simply visit ccpaymentservice.com, and be prompted by the system to complete the transaction. To pay by credit card over the telephone, call 1-888-571-6087. There is a convenience fee for using a credit card. It will be charged based on the amount that you are paying. Payments may also be made in person or mailed to the Vance County Tax Office.
